





Bills

- Utility Companies are not cutting off service due to no payment.
- Many motor insurance companies are issuing refunds on premiums. If you haven't received it or are curious if you are eligible, call you car insurance company.
- The New Mexico State Supreme Court ordered a temporary halt on most evictions.
 - This will only be for non payments.
 - This does not mean that your landlord won't evict you. It just means a judge will hear your case and if they believe it fits the guidelines, they will not legally enforce the evictions.
 - New Mexico Legal Aid will offer free or reduced legal services to those in need during this time. (https://www.newmexicolegalaid.org/)
- Cares ACT signed into Federal law allows homeowners to delay mortgage payments.
- Be careful! As of now, there is no concrete plans for bill forgiveness. When this is all over, the full amount you owe may become due.

The Lobo Food pantry


